### Projects include:

- The Eastport Chamber organizes the annual Salmon and Seafood Festival, always Labor Day weekend.
- The Chamber works with Port Authority and local businesses to support the growing cruiseship business in Eastport.
- The Holiday Lighting Project was launched in 2023 by the Eastport Chamber; and each year will see additional investment in commercial lighting, expanded locations, more holiday events and regional promotion.
- In 2020 the Chamber launched Eastport Totes - collector edition totebags sold by member businesses, featuring different brand logos of old sardine cans, provided by the Tides Institute and Museum of Art.
- The Eastport Buoy Project was a joint effort by the Chamber and the Port Authority; the Buoy was unveiled in 2023 and is the latest photo-op in Eastport!
